1. Conclusion of contract

The contract between you and Sonja & Christopher Kessler results with the confirmation of your written, personal or electronic application / booking. If the booking person notifies other participants, he / she is responsible for their contractual obligation (in particular payment of the price) as for their own obligation. These terms and conditions apply to all participants. Once your registration has been received, this will be confirmed in writing by Sonja & Christopher Kessler. You will be billed at the same time.

2. Services

Which services are included in the price can be found in the program description at www.weisheitspraxis.com. Special requests are only part of the contract if they have been confirmed by Sonja & Christopher Kessler in writing and unconditionally.

3. Application deadline

Early registration helps Sonja & Christopher Kessler, to avoid complications with the booking. Nevertheless, the company is endeavouring to take individual short-term applications into account as far as possible.

4. Prices

Unless stated otherwise, prices are per person in Swiss Francs or Euro. The prices in the booking confirmation are binding. The price does not include: accommodation, getting there and back, travel by public transport or mountain railways.

5. Terms of payment

After receipt of the invoice, a deposit of CHF / EUR 100.- for adults and CHF / EUR 50.- for children / teenagers per person is due. The remaining balance must be paid no later than 10 days before the start of the event. If you book your participation less than 10 days in advance, the entire invoice amount is due immediately. The documentation of the meeting is personal; it must not be given to third parties.

6. You cannot participate

Cancellation of the participation after registering, must be in writing or by e-mail to Sonja & Christopher Kessler. Report. The following cancellation fees are charged as a percentage of the total costs:

30-15 days before participation: 30%

14-8 days before attendance: 50%

7-1 day before attendance 90%

On the day of attendance or in case of non-appearance: 100%.

The Modification or Cancellation date shall be the date on which the declaration arrives at Sonja & Christopher Kessler, Saturdays, Sundays and holidays are subject to the next working day. Substitute: Is permitted if the organizational possibilities permit it. You are personally liable for the payment of the participation fee and any fees.

7. You participate, without termination

If you terminate your trip prematurely for any reason, you are not entitled to a refund of the participation fee or the unclaimed services. In urgent cases (e.g. own illness, accident, serious illness or death of a close person) Sonja & Christopher Kessler will as far as possible help with organization or early return journey.

8. Insurance

Adequate accident, liability and theft insurance is the responsibility of the participant. Valuables, jewellery, watches, photographic equipment, money and credit cards in the car and luggage are not insured by Sonja & Christopher Kessler.

9. Liability at increased risk

Active hikes are usually associated with increased risk. For accidents Sonja & Christopher Kessler are not liable. Sonja & Christopher Kessler presupposes a considerable degree of self-responsibility with each participant: In case of hiking tours, solid mountaineers are required. Instructions are to be followed.

10. Disclaimer of liability

Sonja & Christopher Kessler assumes no liability if the non-fulfilment or improper fulfilment of the contract is attributable to the following:

Failures on your part before and during the participation. Non-foreseeable or ineligible omissions of third parties which are not involved in the performance of the contractually agreed services. In the event of force majeure or an event which, despite all due diligence, could not provide or avert, specific natural catastrophes and official measures. Losing of personal artefacts, cash, photo equipment or other valuables.

11. Unused Services

For services which the participants at the meeting not claimed is not entitled to compensation.

12. Participation obligation

The participant is obliged to act actively and positively in the case of program disturbances or unforeseen changes in performance in order to avoid damage or at least keep it at a minimum.

13. Program change

Sonja & Christopher Kessler explicitly reserves the right to amend the Prospectus prior to booking. Should this be the case, Sonja & Christopher Kessler informs the participants before signing the contract.

14. Change during participation

Sonja & Christopher Kessler reserves the possibility in your interest to change the programs or specific services agreed upon if unforeseen circumstances require and thus no significant program change occurs, or the nature of the meeting is changed.

15. Exclusion of claims and limitation

Claims for non-provision or improper performance of the services, the customer must claim within 10 days after the contractual end to Sonja & Christopher Kessler in writing. Claims received after this period Sonja & Christopher Kessler cannot be accepted, unless the participant can prove that he has been prevented innocent of meeting the deadline.

16. Jurisdiction and applicable law

In contract between you and Sonja & Christopher Kessler only Swiss law is applicable. Subject to mandatory legal requirements is the court of jurisdiction in St. Gallen.
